








Mendawak Landscape – Biodiversity, Forest, and Orangutan Habitat


- PT Mayawana Persada is located in the Mendawak landscape in West Kalimantan, covering two districts: Ketapang and North Kayong.
- Mendawak Landscape only has one conservation area in the form of Protected Forest, covering 20,000 ha with eight Village Forest.
- PT Mayawana Persada is among the most important key actors for the conservation effort in the landscape. The company has been developing industrial forest plantation at the cost of remaining forest in the Mendawak landscape.

Almost 20,000 ha of Forest was Cleared Inside the Concession in 2023




Zooming in: PT Mayawana Persada's Land Transformation from January to May 2023




Some of the Clearing Took Place in the Peatland Area


- The Ministry of Environment and Forestry in Indonesia divides peatland into two categories: protection and cultivation. Both types present inside the concession.
- Peatland is among the most carbon-rich ecosystem on Earth.











PT Mayawana Persada's Concession Overlaps with Orangutan Habitat According to the PHVA Survey (2016)















PT Mayawana Persada's Ownership Structure, until January 2023




PT Mayawana Persada's Ownership Structure Januari-Desember 2023

 In January 2023, 50% of Mayawana Persada was sold to Green Ascend Group [offshore]

• In December 2023 the remaining 50% of Mayawana Persada was sold to Balaji Investment Holdings Group Limited [offshore- Samoa]

• Its unclear whether these are shadow companies of Alas Kusuma.



- The entire area designated as a PT Mayawana Persada concession is rural which is the living environment and living environment for indigenous communities and farmers in rural areas.
- The loss of land means the loss of the source of livelihood and entity as a customary law community
- Oil palm, rubber, durian, cempedak, jengkol and quality timber plantations and even rice fields belonging to the community were forcibly evicted and confiscated.
- Graves, clean water sources and traditional sites were damaged
- Conflict occurs between communities

All of these actions were carried out by force through intimidation, fighting against each other, terror, and even criminalization















PT Mayawana Persada's Ties to Japanese Market

• In 2022, PT Mayawana Persada supplied its timber to several companies, including PT Harjohn Timber, PT Basirih Industrial, PT Wijaya Tri Utama Plywood, PT Putra Kalimantan Sukses, and PT Indonesia Fibreboard Industry. Some of these companies supplied to Japanese market in 2021.



• Among PT Harjohn Timber's Japanese importers, Sumitomo Forestry Co Limited ranked highest, with a recorded total of 6,600 tonnes of net weight imported between January and September 2021.

Note: In an email sent to JATAN on March 14, 2024, Sumitomo Forestry stated, "Three companies (PT. Wana Subur Lestari, PT. Mayangkara Tanaman Industri, and PT. Kubu Mulia Forestry) are 100% owned by our group from June 2021, and our joint venture relationship with Alas Kusuma has already been terminated. In addition, for transactional reasons, no new contracts for the procurement of plywood have been signed since January 2023."





Supply chain suspensions

- In 2023, several palm oil traders have suspended Alas Kusuma through their supplier KPN
- In 2022, a palm oil mill selling to the international market place suspended Alas Kusuma



Why is it important for companies to have NDPE policies?

- Relying solely on the certification may undermine situation like Mayawana Persada.
- Companies should pursue an active effort on due diligence.
- NDPE policies create a system where companies should be transparent about suppliers and grievance mechanism.
- "Lessons learned from palm oil sector":

how the NDPE policy has created an NDPE market with the goal of zero deforestation. If the NDPE market was created, an NDPE system will also be formed which requires companies to be open about supplier information (traceability) and have a grievance mechanism.


